

**Topics for admission interview
for candidates for MA studies in Global Communication**

During the interview a candidate is required to prove that they:

- have a C1 command of the English language,
- know and understand the deep structure of the English language,
- are familiar with various subbranches of linguistics (especially sociolinguistics, pragmatics and discourse analysis), their terminology and research methods,
- have the knowledge regarding key aspects of sociology that are instrumental in linguistics,
- have the knowledge and skills necessary for analysing communication processes (especially those occurring in an international setting),
- have the knowledge and skills necessary for conducting a linguistic analysis of text and other forms of content (especially those published on the new media),
- have the knowledge and skills necessary for communicating in legal and business English
